# Fit for the Future 2003

- The strategy was launched in October 2003
- A comprehensive strategy covering 6 programme areas:
  1. Smoking, nutrition, alcohol, physical activity (SNAP)
  2. Families, Children and Young People
  3. Strengthening Communities
  4. The wider determinants of health
  5. Improving Primary Care Services
  6. The role of the NHS in the local economy
- Communications and Engagement
  - Public facing
  - Events, media coverage



# What has changed?

- A strong LSP with established strategic partnerships
- Improving health and reducing health inequalities is recognised as everybody's business
  - Much higher on the agenda
- Increased public awareness of healthy lifestyle issues
  - Extensive national media coverage

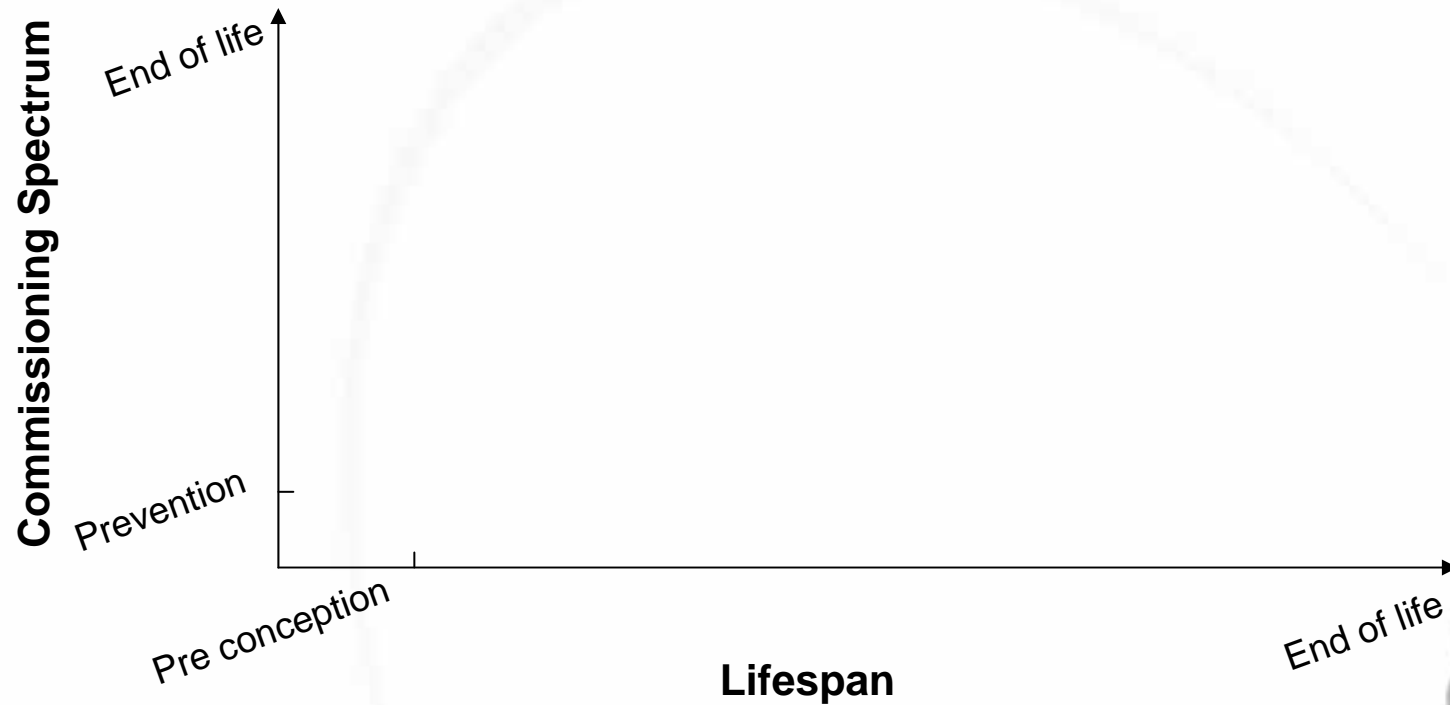
